Key Roles for BikeMarshals.ie motorcycle marshals:

- To inform traffic effectively of impending event convoy/participants.
- Where adverse or heightened risk is evident, to provide appropriate notice to event participants as well as the general public.
- In the event of incident, to provide effective scene management and First Aid skills.

Key Responsibilities for BikeMarshals.ie motorcycle marshals:

- To accomplish all tasks through a System of Safe Working including effective planning.
- To work to limit oneself, event participants and general public to undue or adverse risk situations.
- To project as a professional/proficient and skilled service.
- To work with & complement other event facilitators (e.g. Gardai), event coordinators, static marshals and others (Order of Malta, Civil Defence etc).

Not Responsible for (BikeMarshals.ie marshals are not responsible for):

- Event Risk Assessment.
- Static Marshal Activities (other than occasional temporary static marshalling).
- Event participants who break the Rules of the Road or who travel outside the prescribed event convoy or event route.
